Our Sunday services are cancelled until further notice.



The church building will be open this Sunday 22nd March from 10.30am until about 11.15am (or later if necessary) as a place of sanctuary, reflection and prayer. The Minister will be in attendance.



Please only come into our building if you are well. Otherwise stay at home for your own protection and that of others. Please observe hygiene protocols described on posters and sit at a safe distance from others
