Presbytery Planning

The Presbytery Plan submitted by the Presbytery of Glasgow to the National Committee has been returned with a request for clarification; more detail (about buildings and ministry allocations) and revision.

The Presbytery discussed this at its meeting in December and resolved that an Overture be brought to the General Assembly in May 2023 asking that reductions be not so great.

There is a further Special Purposes meeting of Glasgow Presbytery on 7th February.

Becoming a Communicant member of Williamwood Parish Church

If you – or anyone you know – is not a communicant member of our congregation at Williamwood you or they might want to consider becoming so.

If you have been a member of another denomination or congregation, you simply need to contact the Session Clerk and ask about transferring your membership to Williamwood.

If you have not been a communicant member here or elsewhere, you may wish to speak to the minister. Usually people are 'admitted' during the service where they are asked to profess faith in Jesus Christ by answering a simple question followed by a prayer said by the minister. Sometimes it is possible to become a member by asking the Kirk Session to allow your name to be added to our Roll.
