LENT 2024

During the season of Lent, we are joining with the congregations of Giffnock: The Park; United Reformed Church; Orchardhill; South on Wednesdays at 10.30am to walk between two of our buildings on each day. At the end of the walk there will be a short time of reflection before we enjoy refreshments together.

The short time of music and reflection will be at Williamwood on Wednesday 13th March probably beginning around 11.15am (after some have walked from Giffnock: Orchardhill) See the poster below for further details.

The Minister invites you to read the book of Psalms during Lent as a daily devotional discipline (it amounts to three psalms some days; four on others) OR to read and reflect on Psalm 25 (a prayer for help and of trust in God) on each day of Lent.

MINISTER TO RETIRE...

On Sunday 18th March (the first Sunday in Lent) the Minister intimated to the congregation that she would demit the charge of Glasgow: Williamwood and retire from full-time parish ministry in the summer of this year, almost 9 years after the congregation of Williamwood called her to be their Minister.

The exact date of her retirement and last service is still to be finalised in consultation with the Presbytery of Glasgow.

The Kirk Session (along with Glasgow Presbytery and our Cluster congregations) will now consider how the congregation goes forward and will put in place the necessary arrangements.

PRESBYTERY PLANNING

Representatives from all our Cluster congregations met in early February and heard from a Minister in Irvine who is involved in a team, multi-congregation ministry. There is a further meeting on Wednesday 13th March when other models will be discussed. The Congregation Development Officer of Glasgow Presbytery is expected to be in attendance.
